USOE Mike Hinkley came to TMIS. He suggested going to the www.schools.utah.gov. Click on tracking sheet. It will tell us about bills effecting SCC and schools. Look at HB 127, 189 & 254 and SB 140 & 241, and HJR 12. We discussed HB 254 - changes of timelines for elections and SB 241 – business members as voting members of SCC who don't live or work in the school boundary. SB 140 mayor gets final approval on SIP plans. HJR 12 loosens up investment opportunities for trust land program.
