

# RISE \* Student Sign In


- 1) Have students **RESTART** their computers
- 2) Special Student Laptop Login  
Username = **pcsdtest**  
Password = **pcsdtest**
- 3) Have students turn up the volume on their computer (cannot adjust volume during the test)



- 4) Have students go to Dock and Click on the Questar Icon
- 5) Give students their login tickets.


6) **SAY:** "You should now see a login screen on your device. If you do not, please let me know now." [Pause.] "On the login screen. Please enter your seven-digit SSID and password from the login ticket you have been given." [If login tickets have not been provided, provide students with their passwords as displayed on the View Test Administration page in Nextera Admin.] "Then click the **Sign In** button."

Test Sign in for Students

7) **SAY:** "Please review the information on the screen, making sure your name and the test you are taking are shown. If any of the information is incorrect, please raise your hand and I will help you; other wise, select Yes to continue."
